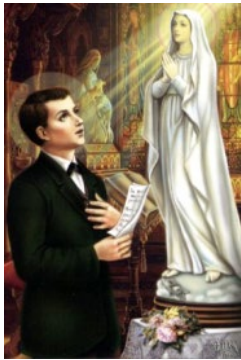

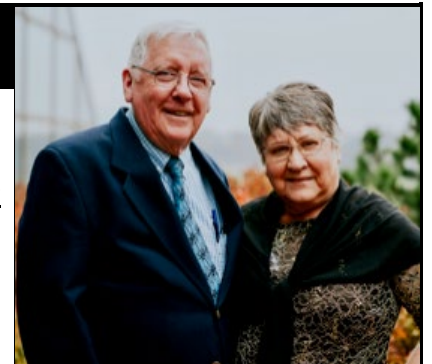

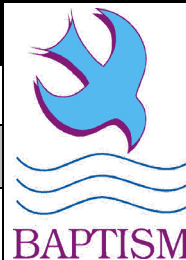

STAGE 3 OF RELAUNCH STRATEGY: EFFECTIVE JULY 01, 2021

There is no capacity limit for in-person attendance. • Masks are not mandatory inside the church. Parishioners who feel comfortable wearing masks may continue to do so. • Pre-registration for Mass and contact tracing no longer need to take place. • No more physical distancing (2m) needed. Part of our church in Rocky Mountain House will be designated for people who still would like to follow physical distancing. • We can have Servers, Lectors, Music Ministers, Greeters/Ushers and Sacristans. • The distribution of Holy Communion will continue under one species, the Body of Christ. • The distribution of Holy Communion on the tongue is allowed. • The Sign of Peace: please offer one another the sign of peace by a bow. A return to a handshake will be evaluated by the end of August 2021. • Music Ministry: All Mass parts can be sung. Congregational singing is allowed. • Hospitality after Mass can take place. • Dispensation from obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues and will be evaluated at the end of August 2021.

• **Funerals, weddings, baptisms, adorations** - no capacity limit for in-person attendance.

INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE SUNDAY

*Amos 7:12-15 * Ephesians 1:3-14 or 1:3-10 * Mark 6:7-13*

Share the Good News with all who will listen. In the first reading and the Gospel, Amos and the Apostles are sent to convey God's perfect message, which tends to make sinners feel uneasy. Like Amos, confronting sin may not have been on our original to-do list. But how else can we open our hearts to receive the grace to boldly go forth to share the Good News to all who might listen?

In the first reading, Amaziah tries to move the prophet Amos away from the royal temple. Saint Paul praises God for his adoption of all people *to himself through Jesus Christ*. In Mark's Gospel, Jesus sends the Twelve out in pairs, giving them instructions on how to approach their ministry with simplicity.

SUNDAY REFLECTION



Those called to lead others to the Lord must first learn to follow him. ● Today, Jesus sends his Apostles on their first missionary journey. He is specific about what they may take with them. They will have to trust in the Lord and depend completely on the hospitality of those with whom they share the Gospel. Where the word of God is welcomed, the one who preaches it will be fed and sheltered. Where the Gospel meets with hostility, the Apostles are to shake the dust from their feet and move on. ● Like the Apostles, we, too, are called and sent by our baptism, called to be disciples of Jesus and called to make disciples for Jesus. One in three people in our country do not profess Christianity, nor do one in three people in the world. Once we accept the call of our baptism, our work is cut out for us: to spread the faith by word and example as the Apostles did, trusting in the Lord and in the kindness of strangers.
